ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

This is to certify:

FIRST: That we, the undersigned, Hope H. Dickson, whose post office address is 33 West Notley Road, Silver Spring, Maryland and Robert L. Ashford, whose post office address is 13313 Banbury Place, Silver Spring, Maryland and John K. Steckel, whose post office address is 13312 Banbury Place, Silver Spring, Maryland, each being at least twenty-one years of age, do hereby associate ourselves as incorporators with the intention of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the General Laws of the State of Maryland.

SECOND: The name of the corporation (which is hereinafter called the Corporation) is ROBIN HOOD SWIM CLUB, INC.

THIRD: The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are as follows:

To own, lease, construct, develop, operate, maintain, manage, sell or otherwise utilize and dispose of suitable facilities for the safe and healthful recreation of the Corporation's members. The facilities are to include a swimming pool, bathhouse, parking area and such other recreational facilities as the Corporation may deem desirable.

FOURTH: The post office address of the principal office of the Corporation in this state is 13313 Banbury Place, Silver Spring, Montgomery County, Maryland. The resident agent of the Corporation in this State is Robert L. Ashford, whose post office address is 13313 Banbury Place, Silver Spring, Maryland.

Said resident agent is a citizen of this State and actually resides herein.

FIFTH: The Corporation is not authorized to issue capital stock.

SIXTH: The number of directors of the Corporation shall be seven (7), which number may be increased or decreased pursuant to the by-laws of the Corporation, but shall never be less than three (3); and the names of the directors who shall act until the first annual meeting or until their successors are duly chosen and qualified are:

SEVENTH: The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

EIGHTH: In the event of dissolution of the Corporation, all funds remaining, after paying debts and other obligations of the Corporation and expenses of terminating the Corporation's business, shall be distributed and paid over to such non-profit,

tax-exempt organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for purposes which are as similar as possible to the purposes of the Corporation, as the Members may select.

On the basis of your stated purposes and the understanding that your operations will continue as evidenced to date or will conform to those proposed in your ruling application, we have concluded that you are exempt from Federal income tax under the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code section indicated above. Any changes in operations from those described, or in your character or purposes, must be reported immediately to your District Director for consideration of their effect upon your exempt status. You must also report any change in your name or address.

You are not required to file Federal income tax returns so long as you retain an exempt status, unless you are subject to the tax on unrelated business income imposed by section 511 of the Code, in which event you are required to file Form 990-T. You are required to file an information return, Form 990, annually on or before the 15th day of the fifth month after the close of your annual accounting period indicated above.

You are liable for the taxes imposed under the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (social security taxes); and for the tax imposed under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act if you have four or more individuals in your employ.

Any questions concerning excise, employment or other Federal taxes should be submitted to this office.
